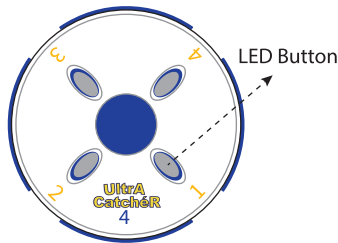
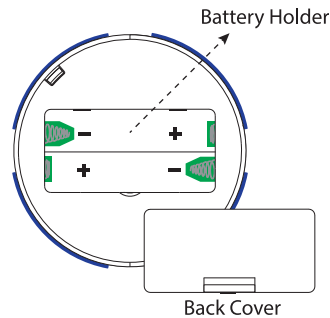
Simple instructions

GETTING STARTED

Remove the battery cover from the back of the main unit and insert two AAA batteries. When the batteries are installed, the four buttons will light up in green.

Each LED button represents an individual account, allowing you to turn off unused accounts to save power. Press the LED button 3 times to turn off the account. When the account is powered off, the button will light up red and will no longer respond.

*It is recommended to turn off the power frequently when not in use to prevent the battery from draining.



STATUS INDICATION

When the power is turned on, the status light will come on once every 10 seconds for 3 minutes.

	Purple Flashing	Connected
	Red Flashing	Batteries are low

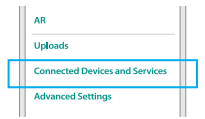
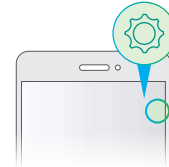
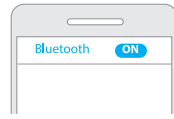
When the battery power is low, the red light will blink continuously once every 10 seconds. If the happens, replace the batteries immediately.

CONNECTION METHOD

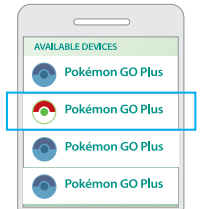
- Turn on your mobile Bluetooth.
- Tap the Main Menu
- Tap [Settings]
- Tap [Connected Devices and Services]



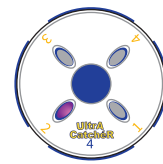
- Tap [Accessory Devices]



- When the Ultra Catcher 4 is turned on, four devices will appear on the screen. When you press any LED button on the Ultra Catcher 4, the "Pokemon GO Plus" icon will light up. Select the "Pokemon GO Plus" you want to pair from the screen and tap it.

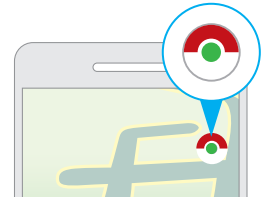


- After successful connection establishment, the LED button on Ultra Catcher 4 will flash purple, indicating activation of the Pokémon GO Plus icon on the screen.



How to connect after completing the connection settings

Launch "Pokemon GO" and tap the icon in the upper right corner of the screen. When the icon becomes bright, the connection is successful.



If the connection fails, access your phone's Bluetooth settings, select "Forget device" for "Pokemon GO Plus", and then proceed to restart the initial connection method.

NTOES

- After operating for 3 minutes, it enters power-saving mode. Functionality continues, but lights are not displayed.
- Due to game settings, it automatically disconnects every hour. You need to reconnect in the game.
- This product is not waterproof or dustproof.
- Please note that the app has a limited movement speed and will not capture or collect anything while moving at speeds above 24 km/h.
- Device requires Bluetooth low-energy compatible smartphone with Pokémon Go app installed. Compatible with iPhone 6S or higher devices with iOS Ver. 12 or higher version installed. Compatible with Android devices with 4 GB RAM or more. Bluetooth Smart (Bluetooth Ver. 4.0 or higher) capability and Android Ver. 7.0 or higher version installed.
